The Scholastic Book Fair will run between 6 March and 12 March in the large hall and we hope you will come along and browse through the wonderful selection of books available. Every book you buy means the school receives 60% commission to spend on new books. Please look at the Scholastic Book Fair leaflet which will also be sent home in due course to show a selection of the books available to buy. Each child will receive a £1 World Book Day voucher which can either be kept to spend at the Book Fair or at participating local bookshops.
