DOLCE AND SCHOOLGRID AGREEMENT -SEPT 2023

Our appointed school meal caterer is Dolce Ltd. Dolce prepares fresh meals daily in our onsite kitchen.

<u>Menus</u>

Parents can order a meal in advance or on the day, before 0850, from a choice including a main meal, a vegetarian meal, a jacket potato or a sandwich/wrap. Children can also order for themselves during morning registration. There is always a choice of salads available, a daily dessert, or a piece of fruit or a yogurt, as well as fresh bread, often homemade. Dolce has a three-weekly rotating menu which is changed twice a year, at Easter and after the October half term.

Dietary Requirements and Allergies

Dolce caters for all allergies or dietary requirements; you just need to advise us at the school if this applies to your child. Once this information is added to your child's account, a touch screen system notifies the Dolce team as your child arrives to collect their meal from the servery, ensuring they can only collect their ordered meal. It also means that you can only order a meal which suits your child. This system also helps the Dolce team greet every child by their first name, which makes them feel welcome at the counter each day.

<u>Cost</u>

All children in Foundation Stage through to the end of Year 2 are eligible for a <u>free</u> lunch from Dolce as part of a Government incentive called the Universal Infant Free School Meal scheme. Once a child moves into Year 3, if they wish to continue to receive a Dolce meal at lunchtime, there will be a charge per child per day, currently standing at £2.75 (unless they are eligible to Free School Meals). If your family is low income or on benefits, your child may also be eligible for an alternative Government scheme called Free School Meals (similarly named to the Universal Infant Free School Meal scheme but different). This entitles your child to Pupil Premium which is a sum of money paid to the school direct for the benefit of your child. Your local authority will check your eligibility for that scheme, but we can provide some further information regarding this if you contact us at the school office. Your child can be eligible for both Universal Infant Free School Meals and Free School Meals at the same time. If required, payments from Y₃ upwards are made via a linked payment card.

Ordering

Dolce uses a system called SchoolGrid for ordering. Once you have completed and returned the form below, we will automatically add you to SchoolGrid and you will receive an email from them with all your necessary login details. By accessing SchoolGrid, you will be able to pre-order meals, view recipes, allergen information and recipes as well as make payments (if appropriate).
