

Free School Meals



- **Do you receive any of the following benefits?**

- Universal Credit - your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of state Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit

If so, you may be entitled to free school meals which can then also give your school additional funding (called Pupil Premium) for the next six years to help support your child. You will also be eligible for any Household Support Fund vouchers made available via LCC (currently £90 per child to be paid by 13 June 2025) and free entry to the Holiday Activities & Food Club (HAF Club) run every long holiday by Acorn Childcare Centre which includes a free hot meal daily.
