## WHERE WILL THE SPORTS DAYS TAKE PLACE? (ACCESS & PARKING)

Sports Days will take place on the field and access will be through the Dundee Drive gate only. The gate will be open 15 minutes before the start of each event and will close at the beginning of the event. If you arrive after the start of the event, please come through the front office and the office team will escort you to the field. Exit will also be through the Dundee Drive gate.

Parking will be tricky as so many parents will be attending at the same time. Please try and walk if possible. If you drive, please park at the Danish Invader pub or the Empingham Road Playing Fields and walk. If you park in any of the nearby estates, please park considerately, legally and safely.

## HOW WILL THIS EVENT DIFFER FROM PREVIOUS YEARS?

The teachers will be running each zone for their class. Each zone will last for 30 minutes and then a horn will sound to indicate rotation to the next zone. The classes will rotate in a clockwise order through the zones on the day. There will be signposted parent spectator areas in each zone. We will be awarding medals on the day in KS2 and in assemblies in KS1.

The class teacher will be organising each zone and will explain the events to spectators.
